Storage and Handling:LINEA FLEXIFELT possesses a semi-rigid structure, requiring careful handling and storage
to prevent damage to the product. To ensure the integrity of the material, it is recommended
to handle packaging and panels with care, carrying them vertically upright with the assistance
of two tradespeople. For optimal preservation, panels should be stored indoors in a clean, dry,
cool, and well ventilated environment, ensuring they are kept elevated above the floor or any
surface emitting moisture. It is advisable to wear clean gloves during the handling process to
prevent any soiling or marking of the product. Caution should be exercised to avoid bending or
flexing the panels, as this may result in creasing.To further safeguard the material, it is important to steer clear of exposure to temperatures

To further safeguard the material, it is important to steer clear of exposure to temperatures exceeding 150°F (65°C). Additionally, panels should not be stored in proximity to radiators, steam pipes, or direct sunlight, mitigating the risk of heat–related damage.

Regular Cleaning:	 Maintain regular cleaning by using a smooth attachment with low suction for vacuuming. We recommend seeking professional cleaning services periodically. Only use upholstery detergent; refrain from using dish washing or laundry detergents. Prior to reuse, ensure thorough drying away from direct heat.

Spot Cleaning:	 Address spills and stains promptly.
	 When dealing with spills, use minimal pressure and avoid vigorous rubbing.
	• Carefully remove soil or blot liquids from the fabric surface; refrain from aggressive scrubbing.
	 Apply specialized cleaning agents according to instructions for spill residue removal.
	 Spot cleaning can also be carried out using dry cleaning solvent.
	• In situations where the product is exposed to excessive moisture, ensure proper ventilation.
